There are so many rare wines in Lots 251-290. This might

be my favorite collection of the whole sale thanks to a longstanding collector who built his collection over decades. Beautiful bottles of **1949 Haut Brion**, **1959 Latour**, **1975 La Mission**, **an OWC of 1982 Mouton**, **six Petrus vintages**, gorgeous bottles of **1962 Vogue Musigny**, **many DRC lots** including famed **1978 and 1985**, the great **1978 La Chapelle**, and so much more, that it is impossible to choose a favorite. This is the stop, look, listen and buy collection of the sale!

Don't miss Lots 398-468 if you collect and drink Rousseau, Dujac, Denis Bachelet, Roumier, Coche Dury, Henri Jayer, Drouhin, Hommage from Beaucastel, Clos St. Jean, Chave, Barroche, Masseto or Colgin. Every lot in this collection is in superb condition from a temperature and humidity-controlled cellar, and it personifies that our NYC auctions offer collectors and drinkers the chance to buy a little bit of everything... everything great!

There is no greater DRC vintage than 1999 and the collection in Lots 468-498 offers a custom OWC of the 1999 DRC Assortment, 2003 DRC magnums and bottles, three Coche-Dury lots, 2005 Clos de Tart in OWC, Vega Sicilia, Giacosa and a most impressive collection of OWC Harlan Estate. This collection is a world tour of great names.

Petrus, Henri Jayer, Leroy and DRC. Yeah, sounds good! Lots 383-397 comes to us from one of the more knowledgeable collectors in the USA. Super-rare verticals of Lafite and Petrus set the stage for a bevy of Burgundy, none brighter than a vertical of Henri Jayer Echezeaux collection back to 1978. If that's not enough, try three twelve bottle case lots of 1989 and 1990 Leroy, a six bottle lot of 1990 Leroy Richebourg, plus a very rare and pristine magnum of 1988 Coche Dury Meursault Perrieres. And that is far from all – two Methuselahs (!) of DRC, for example. I love this collection, and you will, too.



There are two of **our Featured Collections** that are bigger than the rest, **Lots 1-112** and **Lots 655-732**. The first collection contains **wonderful Bordeaux from the 1980s** such as **1982 Mouton, Margaux and Haut Brion**, stellar Burgundies from **DRC**, **2005** Rousseau, an OWC of Marquis de Laguiche Montrachet among many others, great and **deep collections of Giacosa, Masseto, Sassacaia , Screaming Eagle, Bryant, Bond, Harlan, Colgin, Dominus, Peter Michael, Scarecrow and Peter Michael**. This is a great and classically diverse collection from a wonderful collector.

Lots 655-732 is for collectors and lovers of case lots of La Mission, Lafite, Ducru, Pichon Lalande, Leoville Las Cases, Lynch Bages, Gaja, Soldera and the most incredible collection of Bryant Family we have ever seen! There is lot after lot of beautifully cared for wines in wonderful condition.

Speaking of California, we will leave you with two sizzling collections of the red hot **Sine Qua Non, Lots 113-143** and **761-789.** Nuff said.
